Questions/Answers

THE COMPETITION

The AKKA Group organizes a competition every year. It is part of the Group's strategy to nurture a passion for technology among its employees, and to recognize their contributions by promoting their projects.

All the Group's employees (permanent and temporary staff), whatever their roles, can enter individually or as part of a team (maximum of 4 people per team). Entrants should present a project they completed in 2015 up until the competition closing date.

Managers are encouraged to help entrants put together their entries and present their projects. All the information you need about this competition is available on the website <http://akka-awards.akka.eu>.

Can I enter several projects?

Yes, you can submit entries for more than one different project you are working on.

How does the national selection phase work?

When you submit your entry, you choose the country to which you are affiliated, and then the management team in each country will select one project to represent their country.

What type of help should the manager offer?

Managers should encourage employees to enter, and offer support, suggestions and advice about putting together the entry or the presentation.

Are the prizes announced in advance?

The prizes are designed to reward and recognize the contributions of the winners and the nominees; they will be announced during the awards ceremonies.

NEUTRALITY, CONFIDENTIALITY

How can you guarantee the neutrality of AKKA employees during the voting?

To ensure that AKKA employees do not just vote for their country's own project, the project presentation videos will all have the same voiceover, and any mention of the country will be removed from the video.

Will the projects be disseminated outside the company?

No, this is an internal competition. The project details will not be disseminated externally.

Should projects involving defense be excluded?

Projects connected to this sector will not be included in the competition. Generally, it is wise not to include any project in the competition that is subject to national defense classification (military or nuclear projects that require authorization for people to be given access to the information).

Timetable

02 >>> 16 January: Selection by each country's management team of the winning national project

17 January >>> 17 February: National winners produce their videos

20 February >>> 06 March: AKKA employees vote for the winner of the Public Prize
